Knitting for Africa Patterns (all using double knitting wool)

Cot Blanket

The Cot Blanket is made up from Knitted (or crocheted) 6 inch squares sewn together and edged

OR knit in double moss stitch, ie. K2, P2 row 1

P2, K2, row 2

P2, K2, row 3

K2, P2, row 4 and so on.

In either case, knit sufficient rows to form a square.

Sew squares together to form a blanket, approx I metre square, after edging.

Edging: Cast on 12 stitches; knit enough length to go round blanket. Sew on to blanket. (Edging can be crocheted if preferred.)



Colours of squares and edging -your choice.

An alternative method is to knit 6 squares in one strip, changing colour after the first 6" of knitting and continuing in colours of your choice. (There are then only 5 lots of sewing to do!) Again, the edge can be knitted or crocheted.) The blanket above has been made this way

Alter the number of squares if you wish to make a rectangular blanket.
