You will be listened to. We will give you information on how to report abuse within the church, current or historic.

If you're worried that anyone in St George's might be suffering from some sort of **ABUSE**:

- **DO NOT** try to diagnose, investigate or sort it out yourself.
- **THINK HARD** about what is it about the person's appearance or behaviour that is making you worried or suspicious.
- **DO NOT** promise confidentiality if someone talks to you about what might be abuse.
- **DECIDE** who you should TALK to and TALK TO THEM within 24 hours
